


Using Timelines To Break Down Brick Walls


Timelines, which display events in chronological order, are an important part of the genealogist's toolbox for breaking down brick walls.

- Organize your thoughts
- Keep people and events straight
- Add context to your ancestors' lives
- Suggest sources of information
- Assist in analyzing information
- Use to answer specific questions
 - Why did my ancestor immigrate?
 - Which John Smith is my ancestor?



Timelines can include many types of events:

- Births, marriages and deaths
- Military actions
- Immigration history
- Migration trails
- Railroad maps
- Significant social events
- Disasters and epidemics
- Population changes
- Geographic boundary changes
- Technological developments

Timeline Tools

Timelines don't have to be fancy. Scribble an initial timeline by hand. Make a basic spreadsheet, grid, or use online templates. Check your family tree software for built-in options. Here are some ideas for getting started:

Date	Name	Event	Location	Source	Notes

or

Name	1850 census	1860	1870	1880	1900

You might enter ages, locations or whatever information you need to solve a problem.
